Jason Butts brings 12 years of very high level private club coaching experience to WVU. Butts has guided both women and men to Junior Olympic Nationals. He has sent athletes to the Region 8 Championships, while also assisting numerous gymnasts in earning Division I athletic scholarships in the process. Jason has worked the privately owned Woodward Camp and the UGA Gym Dog Camp. He brings excellent camp experience to WVU.



### Travis Doak

#### WVU Assistant Coach

Returns for his fourth season at WVU, Travis Doak after serving as an assistant coach at Penn State University and the University of New Hampshire. He began his coaching career in 2004 as a volunteer coach at WVU. Travis has instructed at numerous college camps throughout the country and Woodward Camp. He has extensive spotting and technical skills as well as being a highly motivating coach.



### Bridget Boyd

#### WVU Assistant Coach

First year assistant coach. Boyd comes to WVU after 12 years of club coaching experience. Additionally, she coached at the last five WVU Gymnastics Camps and will oversee the Mountaineers' balance beam lineup and has experience coaching all four events. Boyd coached Junior Olympic National Championships qualifiers as well as several level 10 regional championships qualifiers and assisted gymnasts in earning Division I athletic scholarships. Boyd also mentored gymnasts to the level 9 eastern national championships. In addition to coaching at the WVU Gymnastics Camp, Boyd also has coached at Brown's Gymnastics Camp (2001) and UGA Gymdog Camp (2001-05, '08).

## Camp Information

### Eligibility

Overnight Camp is open to girls 8-18 years old. Day Camp is open to girls 8-18 years old. Instruction is available for all competitive gymnastic levels.

### Location

The camp is located on the Evansdale Campus of West Virginia University in Morgantown, W.Va., just 70 miles south of Pittsburgh.

### Insurance

Campers must provide their own medical insurance. Campers must turn in a copy of a current physical in order to participate in the camp. The camp has a professional medical trainer on duty at all times.

### Cancellation

The \$100 non-refundable deposit will account for the handling, time, etc. All cancellations must be in writing. No cancellations will be accepted over the phone. The remaining paid tuition will not be refunded until after August 1. If a camper should have to leave early for medical reasons, the refund will amount to prorate of room/board only.

### Discipline

Any serious violations of camp regulations will result in immediate dismissal from camp. If a camper is dismissed from camp, there will be no refund of tuition.

### What to Bring to Camp

All campers need to bring the following: leotards, gym shorts, gym shoes, socks, t-shirts, spending money, towels and a swim suit (optional). Overnight campers also need to bring toiletries, bed linens, pillows, bath towel, an alarm clock, and materials for door decoration contest.

## Housing and Meals

Gymnasts will be housed and eat meals at the WVU Evansdale Residential Complex, also known as Towers. Counselors will be assigned to a block of rooms to provide necessary security and leadership. Rooming assignments will be finalized at check-in. Checking-in with your desired roommate will help ensure your rooming assignment. If you do not have a roommate preference a roommate of similar age will be assigned for you. **Campers will be housed 2 to a room no exceptions.**

## Facilities

You will train in the \$1.5 million Cary Gym. All equipment is new making the Cary Gym on of the finest training facilities in the country. The Cary Gym boasts resi and loose-foam pits for all of the events, trampolines, overhead spotting rigs, a trench bar station, locker rooms and a fully staffed training room.
