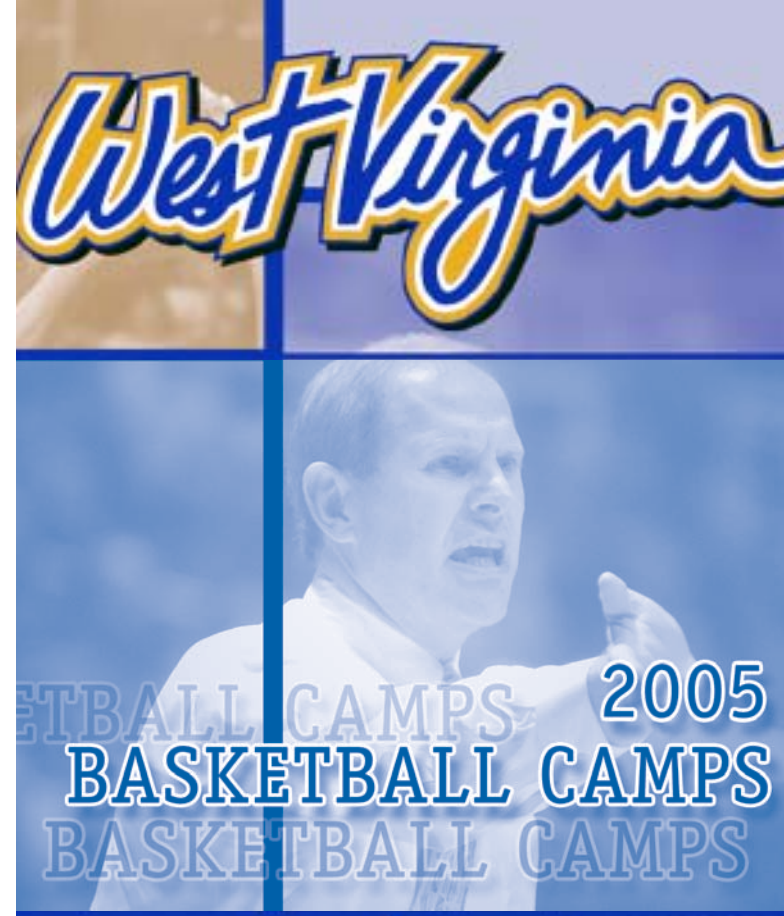

John Beilein Head Coach

John Beilein, who entered the 2004-05 season with a career record of 478-287 (.625), has compiled winning records in 23 of 26 years as a head coach, including ten of the past eleven seasons, and has made seven postseason appearances in his 12 years at the helm of a Division I college basketball program.

Success has followed Beilein at nearly every coaching stop. He has compiled 23 winning seasons and put together 11 20-win campaigns. Beilein is the only person in the collegiate coaching ranks currently to record a 20-win season at four different levels – junior college, NAIA, NCAA Division II and NCAA Division I.

John Beilein will be assisted by his entire staff: Jeff Neubauer, Jerry Dunn and Matt Brown. Also, some members of the Mountaineer men's basketball team and invited high school coaches and college players will be on hand to help teach campers the fundamentals of basketball.

Our camps are a special part of our entire program. Camp Information

Eligibility

All applicants must be between the ages of 8 and 18. High school graduates are eligible to attend if they meet the age requirement.

Location

The camp is located on the Evansdale Campus of West Virginia University in Morgantown, W.Va., just 70 miles south of Pittsburgh.

Insurance

Campers must provide their own medical insurance. The camp has a professional medical trainer on duty at all times.

Cancellation

There will be a \$50.00 cancellation fee to account for handling, time, Etc. All cancellations must be in writing. No cancellations will be accepted over the phone. All cancellations will be refunded after August 1. If a camper should have to leave camp early for medical reasons, the refund will amount to a prorated room/board only.

Discipline

Any serious violations of camp regulations will result in immediate dismissal from camp. If a camper is dismissed from camp, there will be no refund of tuition.

Individual Camp Features

- The camp will focus on your offensive development! Shooting the basketball and your 1-on-1 offensive moves will be emphasized every day.
- Campers will be divided into three leagues and play approximately two games a day. Teams will be formed according to age and ability.
- Some campers' games and/or shooting drills will be videotaped and critiqued by a member of the camp staff.
- Daily lectures from our coaches will emphasize methods for individual improvement.
- Accommodations - Campers will be housed with two in a room in the modern, air-conditioned Evansdale Residential Complex. The ERC is a two-minute walk from camp headquarters, the WVU Student Recreation Center.
- Meals - All meals will be served in the ERC's dining center. An all-you-can-eat meal plan starts with Sunday dinner and ends with Wednesday lunch.
- The camp will end with a brief awards ceremony at 4 p.m. on Wednesday.
