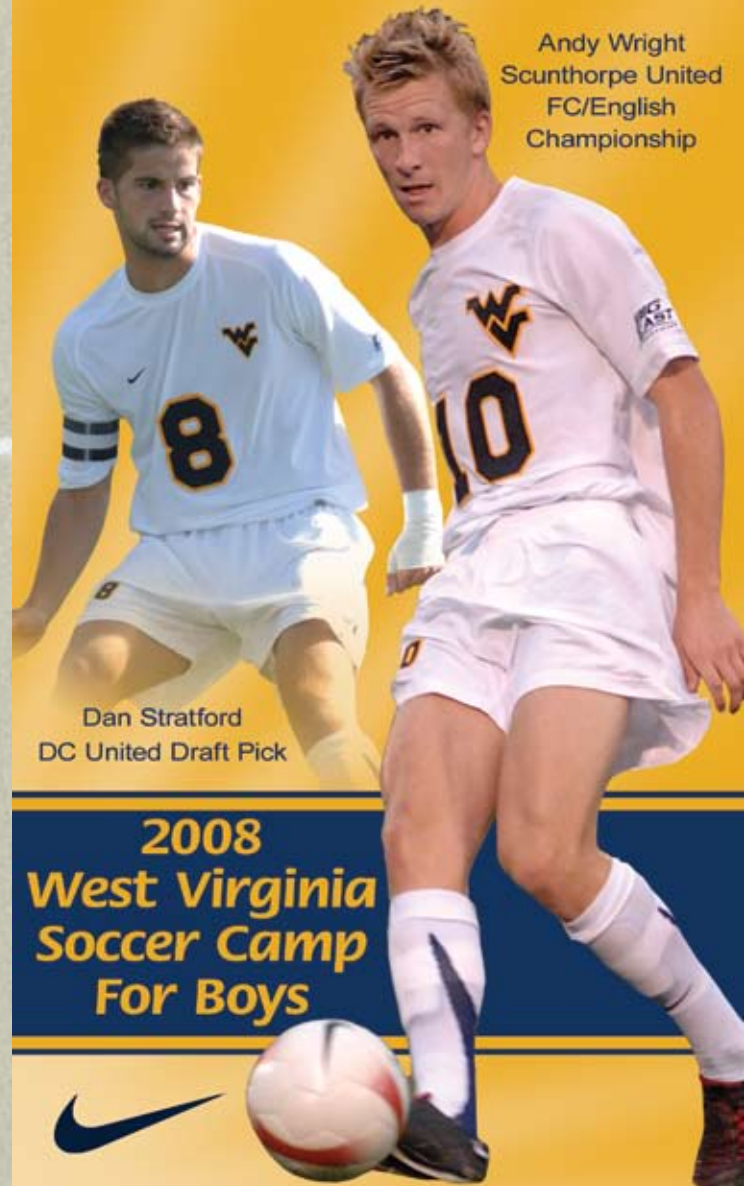

The West Virginia Soccer Academy staff will be comprised of a wide variety of coaches. Our West Virginia University Men's Soccer staff will head a diverse and experienced group that will consist of collegiate coaches, international coaches, former professional players and current Mountaineer players.

PHILOSOPHY

All camps are under the direct supervision of the 2006 National Coach of the Year Marlon LeBlanc. Coach LeBlanc has traveled the world in order to study the "beautiful game." His travels have taken him to England, Brazil, EURO 2004 in Portugal and World Cup 2006 in Germany. It is our goal to teach, share and show the game through many different views as to better prepare our young players. We have created a challenging and competitive environment for serious players and teams. Our camp will focus not only on the technical development of each player, but also challenge them to think through the tactical nuances of the game.

SUPERVISION & DISCIPLINE

Supervision is provided full-time by the staff from check-in to dismissal. Each camper is informed of the camp's rules, regulations and responsibilities. Each camper is liable and responsible for any damage to West Virginia University property. The WVU Soccer Camps for Boys will not tolerate any camper who disrupts the camp, destroys property or does not conduct himself in a proper manner. If inappropriate behavior does occur, parents/guardians will be called and asked to come and pickup their child(ren). NO REFUNDS will be given to campers who leave camp voluntarily or are removed for disciplinary reasons. Parents are responsible for their child's actions.

FACILITIES

Campers will enjoy the state-of-the-art soccer facilities. Training sessions and matches will take place at the Mountaineer Soccer Complex, which consists of a 120 x 75 yard finely manicured grass field and training field. Campers will also play evening matches at Milan Puskar Stadium, which is covered with AstroPlay surface. For inclement weather, the Caperton Indoor Facility will be used. This 95 x 65 yard facility boasts a brand new field turf surface.

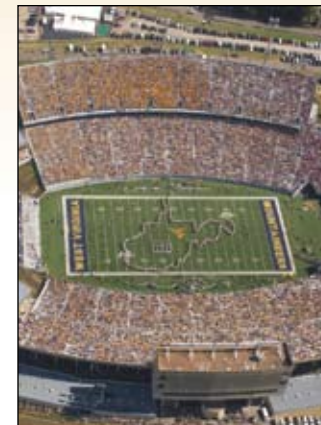

DOES EACH CAMPER NEED TO HAVE MEDICAL INSURANCE?

Yes. Campers are required to have their own medical insurance. Each camper is required to provide proof of a physical within the last 12 months clearing them for participation in the camp. This form must be presented by the time of arrival at the camp. A parent consent form will be provided at arrival and will need to be filled out before you leave. A professional medical staff member will be on duty at all times during the camp.

WHAT TIME IS ARRIVAL AND FINISH?

Check in for the start of the overnight camp will be between 11:30am to 1:00pm. Departure will be immediately following the closing ceremonies at 10:30am on the last day.

WILL I NEED A SOCCER BALL?

No. All campers will receive an official Nike soccer ball.

WHAT SHOULD I BRING?

Campers should bring a pillow, towels, sheets, blanket, toiletries, tennis shoes, daily training clothes and all other soccer related equipment. WVU Soccer Camp is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.

HOW MUCH SPENDING MONEY SHOULD A CAMPER BRING?

There will be a camp store open during break times during the day at the residential camps.

WHAT HAPPENS IF I HAVE TO CANCEL MY RESERVATION?

There is a \$50 (day camp) and \$100 (residential camp) cancellation fee. All cancellations must be in writing. NO REFUNDS after July 1, 2008. NO REFUNDS will be given to campers who leave camp voluntarily or are removed for disciplinary reasons.

IS THERE TRANSPORTATION TO CAMPUS?
